# Water Storage & Supply Projects (\$3.75M\*)

CWP sets a measurable objective of attaining 400,000 acre-feet of water storage by 2050. It also sets a measurable objective of reducing the projected 2050 M&I gap from as much as 560,000 acre-feet to zero acre-feet by 2030.

- Match Requirement: 50% of Total Project Cost
- Completed Application, Statement of Work, Schedule, Budget / Engineer's Estimate
- Applications due Aug 1 & Feb 1; Approved Nov & May

## Water Project Loan Program (Grant match) \$50M



## **LOAN** PROGRAM

- Typically \$50M available from CWCB cash funds
- Loans for water supply projects such as: Reservoirs, ditches & canals, pipelines, river diversion structures, water rights purchases, and hydropower projects
  - Applications are accepted year-round

## **Municipal Borrowers**

Household Income Sets Interest Rate
TABOR Controls
Enterprise Status
Loan Security
Pledge: Tax or Rates, No Tap Fees
Avg Water Bill \$30-\$60/mo
Avg Debt \$2.5K-\$5K/tap

#### Agricultural Borrowers

- •50% of Market Interest Rate
- •Mutual Ditch Companies or Private
- •Revenue: Assessments
- Collateral Decisions
- •Average Operating Cost \$10-\$20/AF



# Project Financing

> \$100,000 minimum loan +/ > Estimated FY2020-21 Rates (30yr)\*
 Agricultural 1.35% - 1.85%
 Municipal 1.90% - 2.85%
 Commercial 6.0%
 \* Reduced if ≤ 20yr



> 1% Loan Service Fee (i.e. \$100K loan = \$1,000 rolled into loan)



## **Approval Schedule** Loan requests **UNDER \$10 Million**

- accepted 6 times/year
- Approved at CWCB bi-monthly meetings
- Apply by 1<sup>st</sup> of month (i.e. April 1st for May meeting)
- Allow 5 months for loan approval & loan contracting

Loan Application Due	<b>Board Meeting Month</b>
December 1st	January
February 1st*	March
April 1st	May**
June 1st	July
August 1st*	September
October 1st	November**



- \* Water Plan Grant application deadline
- \*\* Water Plan Grant approval

Project Cost: \$2,070,000 Grant Request: \$1,035,000 Grant Award: \$975,622 Funding Partners: CDOT \$250,000 Town of Blackhawk \$728,000

Reservoir Volume: 386 acre-feet Dredging Recovered: 62 acre-feet






## Georgetown Lake Dredging


